The 2018 Potentate's pheasant hunt is drawing near (see flyer on pg. 7).

This year we are doing it a little different. The R & G will have our grill there and we will be grilling lunch. So ifwe have a couple of our members who don't want to hunt, but would like to be a part of the day, maybe you would like to be our Grill Masters?

The Pote's hunt is open to anyone, so invite your Lady, buddies, kids or grandkids. Get your RSVP's in soon so we can get a head count to finalize numbers.

For our less mobile hunters we will have some ATV's there to help get you around the fields. Hopefully these

will entice a few more of our longer in the tooth brothers to get out and enjoy the day. Please let me know if you would like to use one.

Cost for the hunt is \$140 and that includes 4 cleaned frozen birds,



quide, dogs and lunch.

Speaking of pheasants, the R & G still has pheasants and rice left. Not near as much as we had a month ago, but still about 60 birds and 50lbs of rice.

Birds are \$10 each and the rice is \$8/lb. With this year's rice crop not looking too good \$8 may be a steal soon, so it is time to stock up!! One pheasant and a pound of rice costs \$18. That \$18 would buy 3 trout for the Camp Achieve outings. You do the math, the more we sell, the more they catch!!!

If anyone is interested in heading up north, especially during the week for a couple days to chase grouse, get a hold of me and we will see if we can get something set up. Between Craig K. and myself, we have quite a bit of ground to hunt about 40 miles north of Deer River.

Looking way ahead, we are again going to try to get out for a late season goose hunt in Rochester, providing the weather and the birds cooperate. It is usually around the first week of December, so stay tuned for more info.
